

N.B.:

1. All appointments take effect on Saturday March 4, 2023. All pastors are to take possession of their jurisdictions by this date.
2. Proper handover notes must be prepared, signed by both the outgoing and in-coming priests and countersigned by the dean and a copy consigned to my office. A comprehensive inventory of parish property must be taken.
3. All parish bank accounts must be accounted for and money said to be left in them should and must be backed with up-to-date bank statements verified by the incoming parish priest together with the parish laity council chairman and the parish finance committee chairman. Incoming priests signing handover notes without verification of things mentioned in the notes will be held responsible for things signed for.
4. A comprehensive account of parish finances to be given to the parish laity council by the outgoing parish priest.
5. All debts, including contributions to the central fund, approved 2nd collections due and levies are to be settled before handing over.
